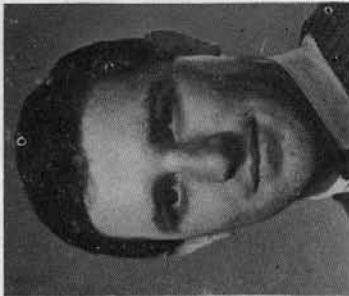
Beverly Gale Driscoll

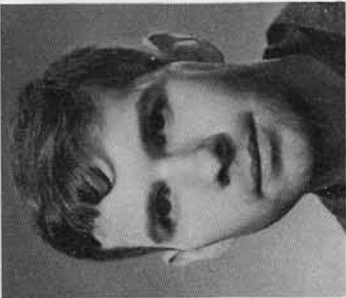
Wanda V. Echevarria

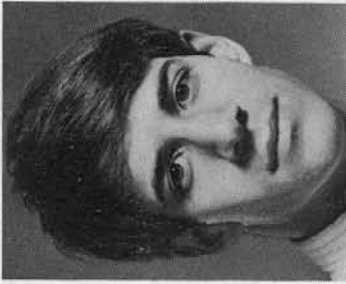
Carolyn Kay French

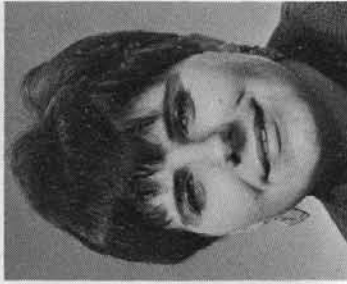
Robert Ellis Fuchs

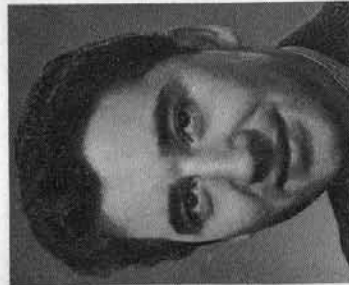
Regina A. Galizia

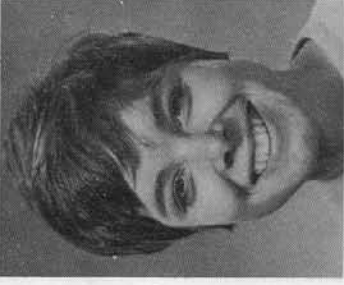
Joseph A. Galvin

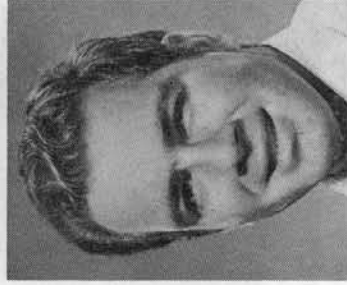
Harold Albin Gershman

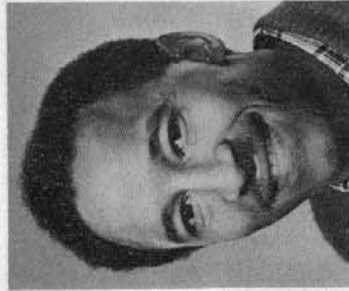
Barbara Elizabeth Gibson

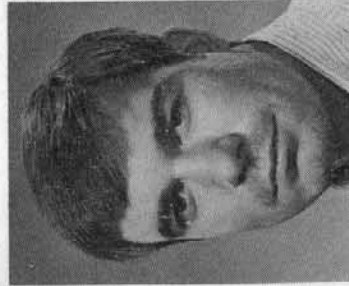
Glenn Greenberg

Diane S. Hibino

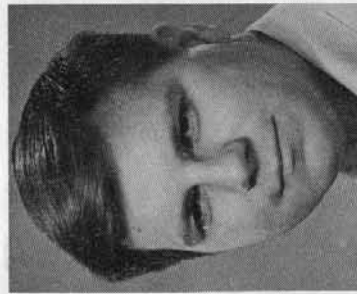

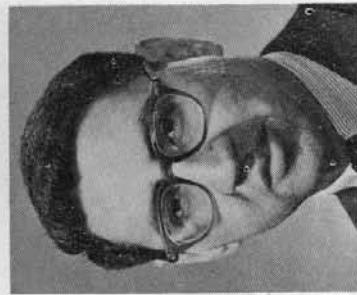
Lona Judy Jackson

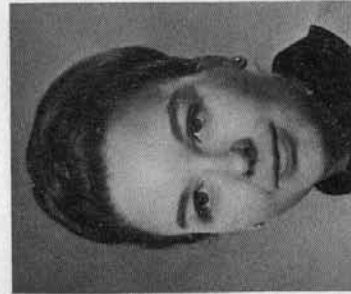
Marianna E. Kennedy

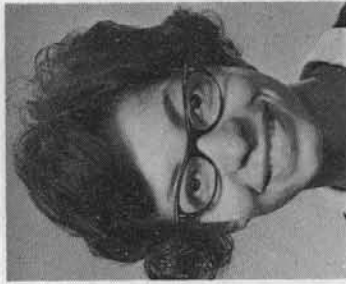
Glee W. LeRoy

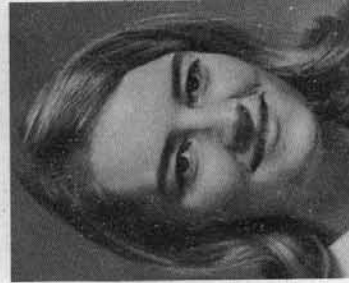
Anne Kathleen McCarthy

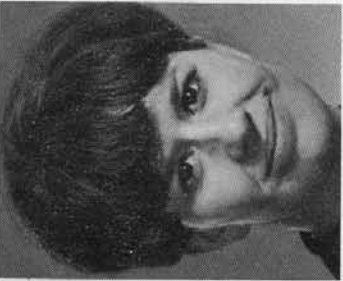
Edna Janet Mullins

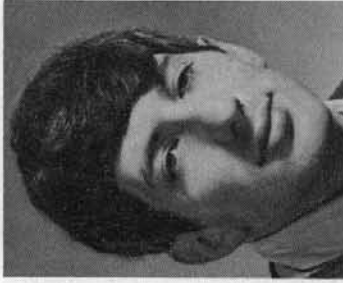
Roberta Ann Nestos

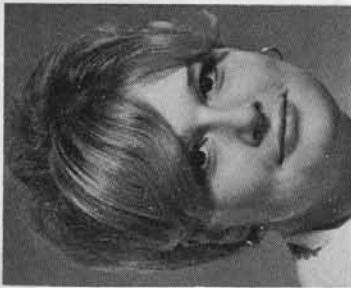
Patricia Ann Nicholson

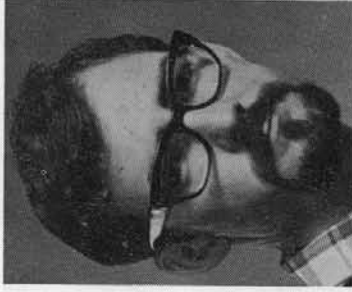
Kathleen Waldron

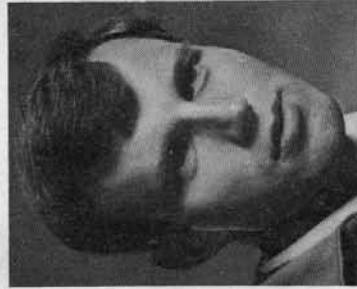
Charles Edward Wardle, Jr.

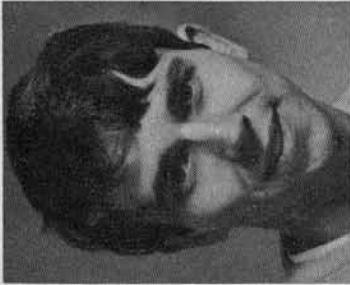
Robert Melvin Whittaker
